Interested students are encouraged to apply as soon as possible for one of the limited slots with an **extended abstract***** by **March 1st, 2014**. The extended abstract should be submitted through the **electronic system**. For more details please refer to the information given in the section "Submission" of the conference web-page. **Please note on the cover page of your abstract: "Doctoral Academy"**. Notification about acceptance will be sent out by the end of April. A full paper is due **May 11, 2014**.

All doctoral students are expected to attend the entire workshop and contribute to the discussion by providing reviews to two papers of other workshop participants. Furthermore, workshop participants need to register for the **Annual Conference**.

Students are discouraged to submit their work to both, the Doctoral Academy and the Annual Conference. Excellent student papers may be included in the special issue of JBE, the Journal of Business Ethics.
